Rules of the Challenge:

1. Answer questions by any means possible, but you can't leave your home.
 - 4-H Project materials, internet, phone interview with your local veterinarian, whatever it takes.
 - You must however, cite where you found it, page if appropriate or date of internet posting, title, etc. If it's a person, their name and title, i.e. Dr. Terry, local veterinarian or Cera Lamken, 4-H Leader, etc. If it's knowledge you just had floating around in your head, write "me"
2. When all pages are as complete as you can make them, email them in as an attachment, NOT as a google doc, the time my inbox receives your email is the time that will be recorded.
3. Each submission will be given points for the number of days from the time I sent this out to the time I receive it and points for each incorrect or unanswered question; the JR, INT, and SR with the least points wins.
4. You do not have to be in an animal science project to play – Entries welcome from all project areas
5. All entries are due no later than 12 Midnight on Friday, March 27... Because a new game is coming on Monday, Mar 30
6. There is a junior, intermediate and senior challenge. (On Sept 1, 2019, Juniors were 9-11, Intermediates, 12-14, and Seniors, 15-19), be sure to compete in the right challenge so your entry can be counted..








1. What type of tooth is this?




